

Everyone Counts In Orange County!



Updated Fact Sheet

- WHY?** The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires more than 400 Continuum of Care jurisdictions across the nation to complete a biennial unsheltered count and an annual sheltered count of all individuals experiencing homelessness in the community on a single point in time during the last ten days of January.
- WHEN?** The 2022 Sheltered Point In Time Count will now be taking place the night of Monday, February 21, 2022, with the 2022 Unsheltered Point In Time Count taking place over three days, Tuesday, February 22 through Thursday February 24, 2022.
- HOW?** Teams comprised of one Team Captain and three Surveyors will be deployed into the community to canvass assigned geographical areas of Orange County. As homeless individuals are encountered by the teams, the teams will administer a survey utilizing a smart phone application, Survey123, to collect demographics, subpopulation information and answers to local questions.
- WHERE?** The 2022 Point In Time Count will be taking place across Orange County on the night of Monday, February 21, 2022. Teams of volunteers will be deployed into each city to canvass the area and survey individuals. Teams will be deploying from one of six the Point In Time Deployment Centers. On Tuesday, February 22, 2022, the teams will be deploying from the Central Service Planning Area; on Wednesday, February 23, 2022, the North Service Planning Area; and on Thursday, February 24, 2022, the South Service Planning Area. On Friday, February 25, 2022, if needed, the City Net team will recanvass areas that may have been missed on previous event days.

Update COVID-19 Safety Guidelines

The OC Health Care Agency, including the Office of Care Coordination and Public Health Services, has collaborated with City Net to implement recommended COVID-19 Safety Guidelines.

As of January 2022, volunteers will need to provide proof of being fully vaccinated for COVID-19 or provide a negative PCR test to ensure the safety of volunteers and people being surveyed.

- For those who have received two-dose vaccines they must have been completed within the past six months while a single-dose vaccination must have been done within the past two months.
 - If it's been longer than six months or two months respectively, a booster is required.
- PCR tests must be completed within 48 hours of the scheduled volunteer shift.
